### **What type of data is collected and how?**

The project partners store data of different types from the Interreg MED Renewable Energy Community WebGIS Platform, through a registration form requesting the following data:

- First name
- Surname
- Organisation/Company
- City
- Country
- Email address

### **For what purposes does the GREENCAP horizontal project of the Interreg MED Renewable Energy Community store your data?**

Project partners collect data to perform their legal obligations as an EU co-funded project.

The scope of the data collected is the minimum necessary for each purpose, avoiding as much as possible personal information. However, no personal information is collected without the knowledge and consent of the target audience.

Data are collected for statistical issues: the GREENCAP horizontal project of the Interreg MED Renewable Energy Community needs to evaluate how many people are reached by the project and from what kind of organisation they belong.

No data will be shared with third parties outside the project and the Interreg MED Programme, other than the external providers or used for unintended purposes without the express consent and prior notification to the interested individuals. When personal data is collected, the purpose will be clearly expressed.

The data collected within the framework of the GREENCAP horizontal project of the Interreg MED Renewable Energy Community will be retained by the project partners and the Interreg MED Programme until **31/12/2028** to comply with the regulatory obligations. Once the retention period has passed, the GREENCAP horizontal project of the Interreg MED Renewable Energy Community partners, potential sub-contractors / external providers and the Interreg MED Programme will take adequate measures to delete all personal data collected within the project.

## EXTERNAL PROVIDERS

The GREENCAP horizontal project of the Interreg MED Renewable Energy Community may use external providers to process your personal data. You will be informed and your express consent required whenever this is the case.
